

## What does that mean?

### *It means <u>Level Z</u> text demonstrates characteristics such as:*

- Unusual text organizations (flashback, flash forward, time lapse)
- New vocabulary words that require using context, glossaries, or dictionaries
- Wide range of challenging themes that build social awareness and reveal insights into the human condition
- Switching from setting to setting, including time change
- Critical thinking to judge authenticity of informational texts, historic fiction, and biography
- Character interpretation is necessary for comprehending themes
- Fantasies are complex, depicting hero figures and heroic journeys
- Informational books include detailed historical accounts of periods less well-known

# How can I support my child in reading?

# I can help by listening, noticing when my child uses good reading strategies, and saying:

- "You noticed when someone different started talking."
- "You made your voice match the punctuation and the story."
- "You thought about what made sense."
- "You noticed that the author wasn't being literal, it was figurative language."
- "You imagined what that word or phrase might look like in order to understand."

## After reading, I can say:

- "Talk about how you can relate to the character(s)."
- "Talk about the character(s) traits and how the character(s) changed over time."
- "What are you still wondering? What would you still like to know about this topic?"
- "Why is the topic important to you or not important to you?"
